


# GOALS

- Share and promote public library resources with students and families in accessible ways.




# WHY PUBLIC LIBRARIES?

- **Multilingual features:** translate interfaces, read-aloud, bilingual content
- **Identity-affirming choices:** representation across languages & cultures
- **Family engagement:** easy to share with caregivers via QR codes & links



- An eCard is a Boston Public Library card that you can [sign up for online](#), [opens a new window](#) and which provides access to [all online resources](#), including [Libby](#), [Boundless](#), and [Palace](#).
- eCards are available to anyone who lives, resides part-time to attend school, owns property, or works in Massachusetts.
- eCards do not allow you to check out physical items such as museum passes, DVDs, and physical books. To check out physical items, you need a physical card.
